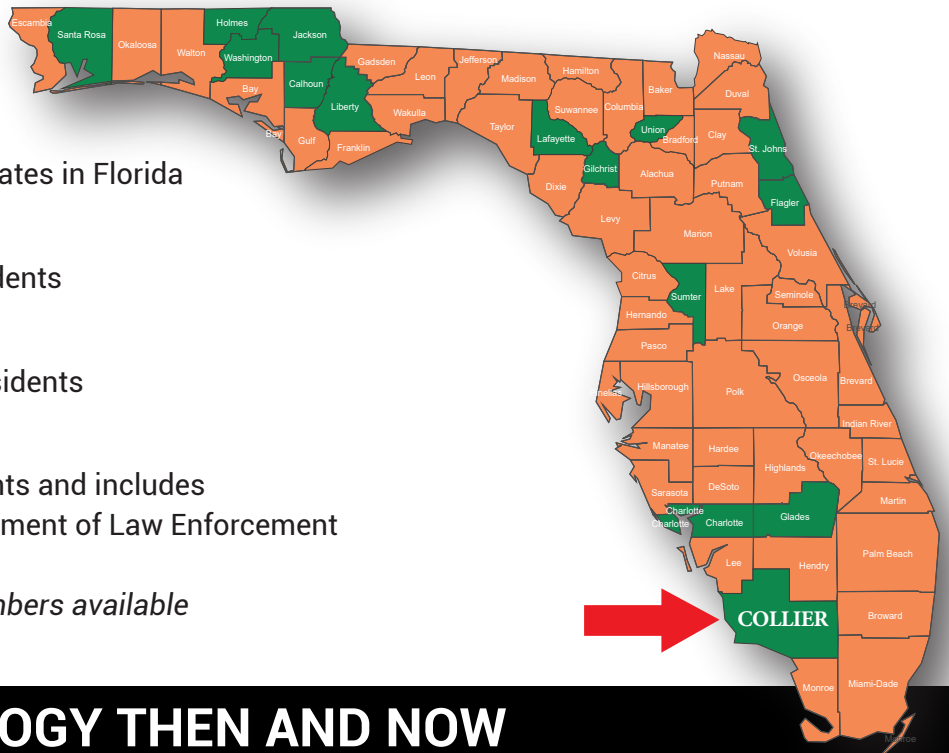
CRIME MAP BY COUNTY

- ★ Dropped **38,000 gallons of water** on brush fires with our helicopter in 2022
- ★ Performed **2,293 community wellness checks** in 2022
