

Items NOT Accepted by the Collier County Jail

Unacceptable Books/Magazines/Items include but are not limited to the following:

- Mail that does not contain the inmates arrest number AND full name
- Books received from a third party sender
- Used Books and/or books with handwritten notes or highlights
- Hardcover Books
- Personal Letter/Photos
- Newspapers
- Hollow Spine Books
- Spiral Spine Books
- Leather Exterior Books
- Books/Magazines containing violent/inappropriate content or nudity
- Coloring Books
- Journals
- Medication
- Personal Checks
- Care Packages (i.e. food, hygiene items, clothing, etc.)
- Racially inflammatory material, pornography, and subversive and violent material. Such correspondence includes correspondence in legal violation of U.S. Postal regulations.
- Unauthorized mail also includes correspondence of escape plans, threats, extortion, and coded mail.
- Any medical devices to include prescription glasses, reading glasses, contact lenses or saline solution.
 - Inmates must first be screened by the Medical Contractor to determine medical need for the items.

Unacceptable Photography include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Arrest documents or photos
- Facility Security
- Any hand signs, including peace sign
- Any illegal substance
- Manufacture alcoholic beverages
- Mask/disguise
- Money
- Nudity (bared buttocks, female toplessness, the use of garments that are transparent/loose, exposing nipples/genitalia)
- Sexually suggestive poses
- Violent in nature
- Weapons
